WHO?

WHAT?

To show YOUR work within MOOD, your achievements, and results.
To have the occasion to exchange knowledge with peers and experts.

HOW?

Posters will be displayed from 27th to 29th June in the dedicated area next to the lunch and coffee break. Presenters should be available for questions, discussions, near their poster during coffee breaks on 28th.

POSTER AWARD:

A poster award will be granted by the Executive Board for the best poster (up to 2000 € to attend an international conference). The award will be announced at the plenary internal restitution on June 29th, 2022.

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR POSTER AWARDS :

1. Academic/scientific quality;
2. Originality of topic/question, clear methodology, consideration of pertinent literature;
3. Overall design (e.g., visually appealing, conveys the project data and conclusions effectively);
4. Presentation Skills.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

1. Submit your poster at mood-coordination@cirad.fr by **June 15th** indicating your full name, email address, institute, and your role. You will then receive a confirmation.
2. Content should include at least the **following sections**: Introduction, material, methods, results, and main conclusion.
3. The maximum size of the poster is size **A0** in **portrait format** (i.e. 84.1 cm width x 118.9 cm height).
4. Presenters are reminded to bring their printed posters to the meeting venue and to give them to the registration desk on the morning of the 27th. **No printing** service will be provided **on-site**. The coordination staff will provide materials for fixing posters on the boards.
5. Use your own **creativity** to craft an interesting and insightful poster. Please respect the sizes.
